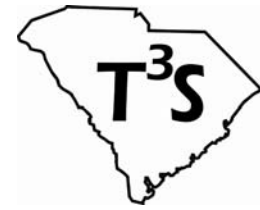

## About the workshop

Please join us on October 24, 2006 to see and hear about a state-of-the-art engineered approach to county road rehabilitation. Take this opportunity to see unpaved roads in Fairfield County rehabilitated and upgraded. This seminar covers how Fairfield County and the Fairfield Transportation Committee is systematically improving unpaved roadways by adding cement to existing gravel roads and surfacing with a bituminous triple treatment. The highlight of the seminar will include a visit to various roads in different stages of the construction process. The contractor will be adding cement to existing unpaved gravel roads and using a reclaimer to strengthen the roadway to a depth of six (6) inches. Compaction and fine grading will then occur in preparation for the bituminous surface treatment. In 2006, Fairfield County will use this process to improve over 13 miles of unpaved roads with an additional 15 miles slated for improvement in 2007. Personnel will be on hand at the project site to explain the equipment and construction operations.
