

Dennis Corporation Receives Chester County Contract

Chester County has selected Dennis Corporation for its Civil Engineering Services Indefinite Delivery Contract, after evaluating seventeen engineering firms' proposals. George W. Thomas, Chester County Contracts and Procurement Director, notified Dennis Corporation on May 21, 2007 by letter, expressing the County's excitement about a long working relationship with Dennis Corporation to improve the quality of Chester County's infrastructure.

Dennis Corporation employees were able to spark the interest of the Chester County Council, at a Council Meeting on March 9, 2007, when they mentioned the flooding of Raxter Road and other issues facing the county's roads. After discussing these issues and considering several solutions to these problems, the County decided to advertise to select an outside firm to maintain their roads and offer solutions to other needs facing the County.

Chester County intends to have Dennis Corporation assist them in the evaluation of existing conditions, planning improvements, developing standards and/or preparing construction plans and specifications for various civil engineering projects. Some of the specific projects could include county roadway design, drainage improvements, GIS mapping, construction inspection, survey capabilities and traffic engineering design assistance.
